



# Shape future of city

PUBLIC input into the city's Bold Future concept is about to shift up a gear.

A team of council employees will be hitting parks throughout the next few weeks to develop the blueprint for the future of the city.

They will be in Kurrawa Park between 8am and 1pm on Sunday, asking the public to fill in surveys.

Bold Future spokeswoman Aimee Tilton will visit the Blaze basketball game on December 5, and the Southport Broadwater on December 9.

The Bold Future surveys cover nine key elements – energy, beaches, culture, the economy, water, environment, transportation, the community and land use.

The findings will be presented in late 2008.

“We are taking Bold Future to the public trying to get as many people as we can to have a say on their own future,” Ms Tilton said.

More community forums are also planned and the team plan to visit parks over the next year.
